

# **Holy Land Pilgrimage in November 2012**

**Dates:** November 3-14 (12 days and 10 nights in Israel)

**Agent:** Discovery Worldwide Ministries in Hurst, Texas (817-595-2700)

**Host:** Dr. David Reagan

Air: Round trip — DFW to Kennedy in New York City via American. NYC to Tel Aviv via El Al, the national airline of Israel. Note: It is not necessary to come to Dallas, if it would be more convenient for you to meet us in New York City. Our tour broker can give you the cost of the trip out of New York City. If you want to use your air miles, you can meet us in Tel Aviv, and all you will have to pay is the Israel ground cost of the trip. Again, our

tour broker can supply you with that information.

**Hotels:** 2 nights in Tel Aviv at the Dan Panorama Hotel

2 nights in Tiberias at Emily's Boutique Hotel 6 nights in Jerusalem at the Mount Zion Hotel

**Meals:** Three meals daily in Israel consisting of buffet breakfast, lite lunch, and full dinner.

Bus: Deluxe air-conditioned motorcoach with an English-speaking Israeli guide.

**Itinerary:** (1) Sat, Nov 3 — Depart Dallas at 11:50am for New York City, arriving there at

4:10pm. Transfer from LaGuardia to Kennedy. Depart Kennedy on El Al Airlines (the national airline of Israel) at 11:50pm.

Meals served in flight.

(2) Sun, Nov 4 — Arrive in Tel Aviv at 4:10pm. Overnight in Tel Aviv.

(3) Mon, Nov 5 — Old Jaffa & Tel Aviv — Carmel Market / Dizengoff Street /

Dugit Messianic Center / Independence Hall. Overnight in Tel

Aviv.

(4) Tue, Nov 6 — Tel Aviv to Tiberias — Caesarea Maritime / Mt. Carmel / Haifa

/ Akko / Tiberias. Overnight in Tiberias.

(5) Wed, Nov 7 — The Galilee — Cruise on Sea of Galilee / Hill of the Beatitudes /

Capernaum / Korazin / Yardenit / Tiberias. Overnight in

Tiberias.

(6) Thr, Nov 8 — Tiberias to Jerusalem — Nazareth / Megiddo / Beit Shean / Jor-

dan Valley / Jerusalem. Overnight in Jerusalem.

(7) Fri, Nov 9 — Jerusalem — Mt. of Olives / Old City / Mt. Zion / Upper Room.

Overnight in Jerusalem.

(8) Sat, Nov 10 — Dead Sea — Masada / Qumran. Overnight in Jerusalem.

(9) Sun, Nov 11 — Jerusalem — Mt. Herzl Cemetery / Holocaust Museum / Dead

Sea Scrolls Museum / Bethlehem. Overnight in Jerusalem.

(10) Mon, Nov 12 — Free Day in Jerusalem. Overnight in Jerusalem.

(11) Tue, Nov 13 — Garden Tomb / Yad Hashmona Messianic Moshav / Kiriath-

jearim. Transfer to Tel Aviv Airport after dinner.

(12) Wed, Nov 14 — Departure for States at 12:30 am. Arrival in New York City at

5:55am. Transfer to domestic flights. Dallas group arrives back

in Dallas at 12:50pm.

Cost: Basic cost is \$4,200 per person. This price includes all transportation, lodging, meals,

taxes, and a fuel surcharge. It does not include tips. There is always a possibility that the

airline may increase the fuel surcharge.

**Tips:** Tips are \$96 per person.

**Single Room:** \$900 additional.

**Registration:** A deposit of \$500 per person is required at the time of registration. Final payments are

due sixty (60) days prior to departure (September 4th).

We are limiting this tour to the first 50 people who register. To register, fill out the form on page 4 and mail it to Discovery Worldwide Ministries together with a check for your registration fee. Or, you can register through their website at www.discoveryworldwideministries.com. Please be sure to read carefully the tour conditions which are outlined below. The registration deadline is August 1st.

### TOUR CONDITIONS

**Payment:** Credit cards may be used for **deposits** only.

**Air Transportation**: Via jet economy class on El Al Airlines. Tickets must be completed 30 days prior to departure. Tickets cannot be changed once issued.

**Deviations/Stopovers**: An individual change in the return date that is a deviation from the basic group itinerary will **not** be allowed.

Hotels: Four or five star hotels throughout. Prices are based on two persons sharing a twin-bedded room with private bath. Single rooms subject to availability for an additional cost of \$900. If a passenger cannot supply a roommate and Discovery Worldwide Ministries is unable to do so, or your roommate cancels before departure, the passenger will have to pay the supplemental charge. (You may be billed after the final payment date for single room accommodations as necessary.)

**Sightseeing:** Local transportation is by deluxe, air-conditioned motor coach. The services of an English-speaking guide and entrance fees to places visited are included in your tour price.

**Airport Taxes:** Included in the cost of your tour is \$706 for airport taxes and fuel surcharges (as of 5/22/2012). **Taxes and fuel surcharges may change without notice.** Any increase will be billed to the passenger and must be paid prior to departure.

## Not Included

Passport costs, beverages (including coffee and tea) not usually included with regular meals; optional tours and excursions not mentioned in the itinerary; accident and baggage insurance; and transporting and handling excess luggage (each person is limited to one checked bag). **Tips of \$96 will be included on your final invoice.** (Again, taxes and fuel surcharges may change without notice and any increases will be billed to the passenger. Any changes will be reflected on your airline ticket.) In the event it becomes necessary to overnight material due to late receipt of registration or final payments, traveler will be billed for these charges.

### For Your Protection

**Insurance**: Acting only as agents for suppliers, Discovery Worldwide Ministries is not responsible for damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident and/or illness. For your own protection, it is important that you have adequate insurance to cover these

possibilities. You should carry proof of insurance in the event you need medical attention while in Israel. Additional information and application forms for all types of coverage will be supplied to you prior to departure.

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION — PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Passport: A valid passport is required and must be obtained in person by each tour member. No visas are required for Israel. Your passport must be valid for a minimum of six months after your return date. The airline will not allow you to board the departure flight from the United States unless your passport expiration date is valid for six months beyond your return date.

Registration & Deposit: A deposit of \$500 per person is required at the time of registration. The registration deadline is August 1st. After that date a \$30 late registration fee will be charged. Only the deposit may be charged to your Visa, MasterCard, or American Express. The remainder of your balance due must be paid by check. You may fax your registration with a credit card number to 817-595-1682. Registrations must be submitted by mail or fax. No registrations will be accepted by phone. Registrations received inside sixty (60) days of departure must be accompanied by full payment, plus a \$30 late registration fee.

Payments: After you have registered for the tour, you will receive an invoice with final payment amount and date due. Final payments need to be made with a check payable to Discovery Worldwide Ministries and must be received sixty (60) days prior to departure (September 4th). Final payments received inside sixty (60) days will be assessed a \$30 late payment fee. NOTE: All reservations not fully paid by the sixty-day deadline are subject to cancellation, for which Tour Operator is not to be held responsible.

## **Cancellations and Refunds**

If a passenger cancels his/her tour membership for any reason, there will be a cancellation fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) to cover administrative and communication costs. For cancellations from 90-60 days an additional \$100 is charged by the airline for a total cancellation fee of \$200. Cancellations received 59-31 days prior to departure: 25% of tour cost; 30-15 days: 50%; **No refund** for cancellations within fourteen (14) days of departure. Trip cancellation and interruption insurance is available and is highly recommended. All cancellation requests must be addressed to Discovery Worldwide Ministries in writing. Phone calls for cancellations cannot be accepted.
