




Lamb & Lion “Battle for Israel” Pilgrimage — September, 2020

This exciting new venture in the Holy Land builds on the foundation of the spiritual pilgrimage designed by Dr. David Reagan, the founder of Lamb & Lion Ministries. Tim Moore will serve as the host for this exciting adventure.

During the pilgrimage, you will visit key battle sites throughout Israel—from the Old and New Testament period, the modern nation of Israel, prophesied future battles, and spiritual battles. This is not just a tour; it is a spiritual experience designed to bring the Bible alive to you and draw you into a closer relationship with the Lord—the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob who protects and preserves those who are His. We will see God’s manifest providence to Israel.

You’ll spend two nights in Tel Aviv, three in Tiberias (on the shore of the Sea of Galilee) and five in Jerusalem. Your flight to Tel Aviv will be round trip out of Dallas via Lufthansa Airlines.

He also serves as the Associate Evangelist for Lamb & Lion Ministries and will succeed Dr. Reagan in 2021. He represents the ministry as a teacher and preacher at churches and conferences around the nation. Tim was trained to lead pilgrims to Israel by Dr. Reagan, and has hosted a number of pilgrimage groups. “Battle for Israel” Pilgrimage in September, 2020

Dates: September 12-23, 2020

Agent: Discovery Cruises and Tours (DC&T) in Hurst, Texas (817-595-2700)

Host: Tim Moore

Air: Round trip — DFW to Israel via Lufthansa Airlines. The flight from Dallas is directly to Frankfurt, where we will change planes and proceed on to Tel Aviv. Returning to the States, we will change planes again in Frankfurt. If you want to use your accumulated air miles, you can meet us in Tel Aviv, and all you will have to pay is the Israel ground cost of the trip. Our tour broker can supply you with that information.

Hotels: 2 nights in Tel Aviv at the Herods Hotel
3 nights in Tiberias at the Leonardo Plaza Hotel
5 nights in Jerusalem at the Dan Panorama Hotel

Meals: Three meals daily in Israel consisting of buffet breakfast, light lunch, and full dinner.

Bus: Deluxe air-conditioned motorcoach with an English-speaking Israeli guide.

- Itinerary:** (1) Sat, Sep 12 — **Depart Dallas for Frankfurt.** Change planes in Frankfurt and proceed non-stop to Tel Aviv. Meals served in flight.
- (Planned)** (2) Sun, Sep 13 — **Arrive in Tel Aviv** in the late afternoon. Overnight in Tel Aviv.
- (3) Mon, Sep 14 — **Old Jaffa & Tel Aviv** — Etzel Museum / Independence Hall / Joppa / Palmach Museum / Rabin Assassination Site. Overnight in Tel Aviv.
- (4) Tue, Sep 15 — **Tel Aviv to Tiberias** — Via Mares / Ebenezer / Mt. Carmel / Haifa / Acco / Overnight in Tiberias.
- (5) Wed, Sep 16 — **Golan Heights** — Tel Hazor / Tel Faher / Mount Bental / Caesarea Philippi / Kursi / Gamla. Overnight in Tiberias.
- (6) Thur, Sep 17 — **Northern Israel** — Lebanese Border / Mt Adir / Kibbutz Degania / Yardenit. Overnight in Tiberias.
- (7) Fri, Sep 18 — **Central Israel to Jerusalem** — Mount Tabor / Tel Megiddo / Gideon Spring / Mt Gilboa Bet Shean / Jericho / Arrive Jerusalem. Overnight in Jerusalem.
- (8) Sat, Sep 19 — **Old City of Jerusalem** — Tomb of Samuel / Radar Hill, Samuel Overlook / Ammunition Hill / Lion’s Gate / Paratroopers’ Walk to Western Wall / Pool of Bethesda / Church of Holy Sepulcher / Antonio Fortress / Mount Herzl. Overnight in Jerusalem.
- (9) Sun, Sep 20 — **North and West of Jerusalem** — Elah Valley / Tel Lachish / Latrun / IDF Armor Corps Museum / Mount of Olives / Dominus Flevit. Overnight in Jerusalem
- (10) Mon, Sep 21 — **South of Jerusalem and the Negev** — Gush Etzion / Beer Sheba / IAF Museum. Overnight in Jerusalem.
- (11) Tue, Sep 22 — **Jerusalem** — Friends of Zion Museum / Garden of Gethsemane / Garden Tomb. Transfer to Airport. Free afternoon/evening.
- (12) Wed, Sep 23 — **Departure & Arrival in the States.** Meals Served in Flight.

Cost: Basic cost is **\$4,720** per person. This price includes all transportation, lodging, meals, taxes, and a fuel surcharge. It does not include tips. There is always a possibility that the airline may increase the fuel surcharge which currently is \$780. (**Ground Only price is \$3,170.**)

Tips: Tips are **\$168 per person** (\$14 per day).

Single Room: \$1,300 additional.

Registration: A deposit of \$500 per person is required at the time of registration. Final payments are due ninety (90) days prior to departure (June 12).

We are limiting this tour to the first 50 people who register. To register, call Discovery Cruises and Tours (DC&T) and then fill out the form on page 5 and mail it to them along with a check for your registration fee. Please be sure to read carefully the tour conditions which are outlined below.

TOUR CONDITIONS

Included in Your Tour Price

Price: Prices quoted are per person and in US dollars and are based on fares and costs in effect at the time of publication. Whenever possible, DC&T obtains price guarantees from suppliers. However, depending upon the strength of the US dollar and the fluctuating nature of oil, gas and other costs, published rates are subject to change without notice. **Credit Cards** may be used for the **deposit** only. Final payment must be made by personal check, cashier check, money order, or cash.

Air Transportation: Via jet economy class on Lufthansa German Airlines. Tickets must be completed 45 days prior to departure. Tickets cannot be changed once issued. **Note:** Passengers may arrange their own air & pay the ground price. Passengers doing their own air MUST meet the group at the airport or hotel.

Deviations/Stopovers: An individual change in the return date that is a deviation from the basic group itinerary will NOT be allowed unless "Ground Only" tour is booked.

Hotels: Four & five star hotels throughout. Prices are based on two persons sharing a twin-bedded room with private bath. **Single rooms** are subject to availability for an additional cost of **\$1,300. If a passenger cannot supply a roommate and Discovery Cruises and Tours is unable to do so, or your roommate cancels before departure, the passenger will have to pay the supplemental charge.** (You may be billed after the final payment date for single room accommodations as necessary.)

Meals: Three meals daily: breakfast, lunch and full dinners upon arrival in Israel.

Sightseeing: Local transportation is by deluxe, air-conditioned motor coach. The services of an English-speaking Israeli guide and entrance fees to places visited are included in tour price.

Airport Taxes/Surcharges: Included in the cost of the tour is \$780 for airport taxes and fuel surcharges (actual cost as of 10/15/2019) **Note:** (Taxes and fuel

surcharges may change without notice. Any increase will be billed to the passenger and must be paid prior to departure.)

Not Included in the Tour Price

Passport costs; food and beverages not usually included with regular meals; optional excursions not mentioned in this itinerary; accident and baggage insurance; and transporting and handling excess luggage. **Tips of \$168 will be included on final invoice.** If it becomes necessary to overnight material due to late receipt of registration or final payments, traveler will be billed for these charges.

For Your Protection

Insurance: Acting only as agents for suppliers, Discovery Cruises and Tours is not responsible for damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident and/or illness. For your own protection, it is important that you have adequate insurance to cover these possibilities. You should carry proof of insurance in the event you need medical attention while in Israel. Upon receipt of your statement, via an email, the link for optional insurance will be provided.

Important Information Please Read Carefully

Passport: A valid passport is required and must be obtained in person by each tour member. No visas are required for Israel. A valid passport is required to leave the USA. **It should be valid for a minimum of SIX MONTHS after your return date;** you will be denied boarding if your passport is not valid for SIX MONTHS beyond your return date (March 23, 2021).

Registration & Deposit: A deposit of \$500 per person is required at the time of registration. The deposit may be charged to your Visa or MasterCard. Registrations received inside ninety (90) days (after June 12) must be accompanied by full payment, and a \$30 LATE REGISTRATION FEE will be assessed.

Payments: After you have registered for the tour, you will receive an invoice with final payment amount and date due. Final payments should be made payable to DISCOVERY CRUISES AND TOURS and must be received ninety (90) days prior to departure (June 12). Final payments received inside ninety (90) days will be assessed a \$30 LATE PAYMENT FEE. NOTE: ALL reservations not fully paid by the ninety-day deadline are subject to cancellation, for which the Tour Operator is not to be held responsible.

Airline Seats: Seats without a deposit must be released 100 days from departure. If you cancel your airline seat with DC&T in writing within the 100 days there is a penalty of \$100 per person.

Cancellations and Refunds

If a passenger cancels his/her tour membership for any reason up to 90 days prior to departure (June 14) there will be a cancellation fee of two hundred dollars (\$200) to cover administrative and communication costs. For cancellations from 90-75 days prior to departure there will be a cancellation fee of \$500. Cancellations received 74-59 days prior to departure: penalty is 25% of tour cost; 58-30 days: penalty is 50% of tour cost; NO REFUND for cancellations within 29 days of departure. *Trip cancellation and interruption insurance is available and is highly recommended.* All cancellation requests must be addressed to Discovery Cruises and Tours in writing. Phone calls for cancellations cannot be accepted.

Tour Operator Responsibility
